

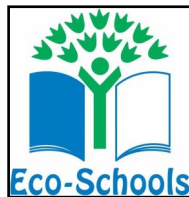
School Council

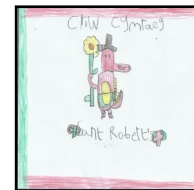
Eco Committee

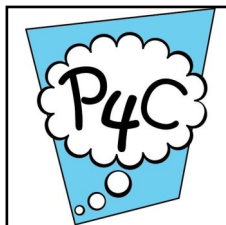
Super Ambassadors
